
- a. Teaching-Learning Process and Resources

### **Survey Methodology**

CMR Technical Campus conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey in December 2020 for the academic session 2019-20. The survey covered all active students where they are required to complete the Student Satisfaction Survey form online. SSS was designed as per the guidelines given by NAAC. The survey responses from 502 students were electronically tabulated for analysis and continual improvement to processes and systems.




Observation:




Observation:




Observation:




Observation




Observation:




Observation


A total of 72% of students believe that the institute takes initiative in promoting internships, student exchange & field visits for students.




**Observation**




**Observation**




Observation:




Observation:




Observation:


Observation:


A total of 84% of students believe that teachers can identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome the majority of times.




### Observation




### Observation:




### Observation:




Observation:




Observation:


A total of 75% of students agreed that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process in the institute is good.




Observation:




Observation:




Observation:
