It is the finale of Azaadi ka Amrit Mahotsav program. 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' celebrates the many achievements of the nation. It involves paying tribute to the 'Veers' who protect our nation. We affirm our bond to the nourishing earth and honor our braves with the following simple actions:

- 1) Dedication of Shilaphalakam-installation of nameplate of Veers.
- 2) Taking the Panch Pran Pledge.
- 3) Vasudha Vandan—creation of Amrit Vatika with 75 saplings of indigenous trees.
- 4) Veeron Ka Vandan- honoring freedom fighters/braves that protect the nation and families of braves.
- 5) Hoisting of National Flag and singing of National Anthem.
