### **INTRODUCTION:**

**SVEEP** is the flagship program of the Election Commission of India for voter education, spreading voter awareness and promoting voter literacy in India. It is a multi-intervention programme that reaches out through different modes and media to educate citizens, electors, and voters about the electoral process in order increase their awareness their informed and promote participation. SVEEP is designed according to the socio-economic, cultural, and demographic profile of the state as well as history of electoral participation in previous rounds of elections. The Commission produces several voter awareness materials and disseminates the through various same mediums/platforms of communication.

### **VOTER AWARENESS PROGRAM:**

In view of General Elections in Telangana, NSS Unit of CMRTC has organised a voter's awareness program in association with SVEEP. The agenda of the session is to make all the faculty and teachers to enrol for vote and to motivate everyone to utilize their vote power.

The students who have crossed 18 years age are the target audience and the speakers have given the inputs related to the need and importance of the vote. The new voter registration links were shared with the student communities for making voter registrations easier in view of budding youngsters.

The program has been focused on the efforts that are making by the Government in making all the people to utilize their vote power in electing a right person for the development of the society. The value of casting vote and how it can decide the fate of the state and nation are exclusively discussed by the speakers.

Dr. A Raji Reddy sir – Director of CMRTC has motivated all the students to utilise their vote power and given certain guidelines for the students those who got vote power recently. He made everyone to take the voters pledge.

After the program NSS volunteers reached each and every classroom and campaigned about the registration procedure and the value of the vote. The mission has been continued for a week. Before the day of elections the volunteers reached all the students and informed to cast their vote.

The guidelines that have to be followed while casting the vote and the documents that have to be carried to the election booth have been shared with all the student communities by the NSS Unit. All over 400 plus students registered for vote from the institute. Even the institute also helped student parents and relatives for registering their vote.

All the volunteers gathered for a meeting on 29-11-2023 and made certain resolutions for the general elections. Program officer has addressed all the volunteers about the value of casting vote and making people to be enrolled for utilizing their vote power that has been given by the constitution to every citizen. Volunteers have been instructed to support general election in their areas in making all the people to cast their vote. At the same time to support elder persons to reach election booths for casting their vote. Even they were instructed to help the election officers in all the way by wearing NSS badges. They were instructed clearly not to speak in support any political party or with any political leaders in the election booth or not to do any kind of favour by misusing their duty.

## **National Voters Day:**

On the occasion of National Voters Day 200 plus volunteers have been taken voters e-pledge and received certificates on 25-01-2024. The theme of National Voters Day 'Nothing Like Voting, I Vote for Sure' 2024 has been explained to the volunteers

All the volunteers have promised to educate as many as possible to increase the voting percentage during the elections. Especially in view of upcoming Lok sabha elections volunteers have been insisted clearly to make certain plans for conducting voter awareness camps and voter registration camps by reaching remote areas nearby.
