Furthermore, owing to learnings in previous editions, new reform areas have been identified which are aimed at capacity building, connecting mentors to startups as well as promoting comprehensive entrepreneurial growth. The 2020 Ranking Framework spans across seven reform areas imperative for the growth of a startup ecosystem: Institutional Support, Fostering Innovation & Entrepreneurship, Access to Market, Incubation Support, Funding Support, Mentorship Support and Capacity Building of Enablers. With a total of 26 Action Points, a combination of absolute, relative and feedback-based scoring is mapped to arrive at a holistic picture of the State/UTs support to their respective startup ecosystem. 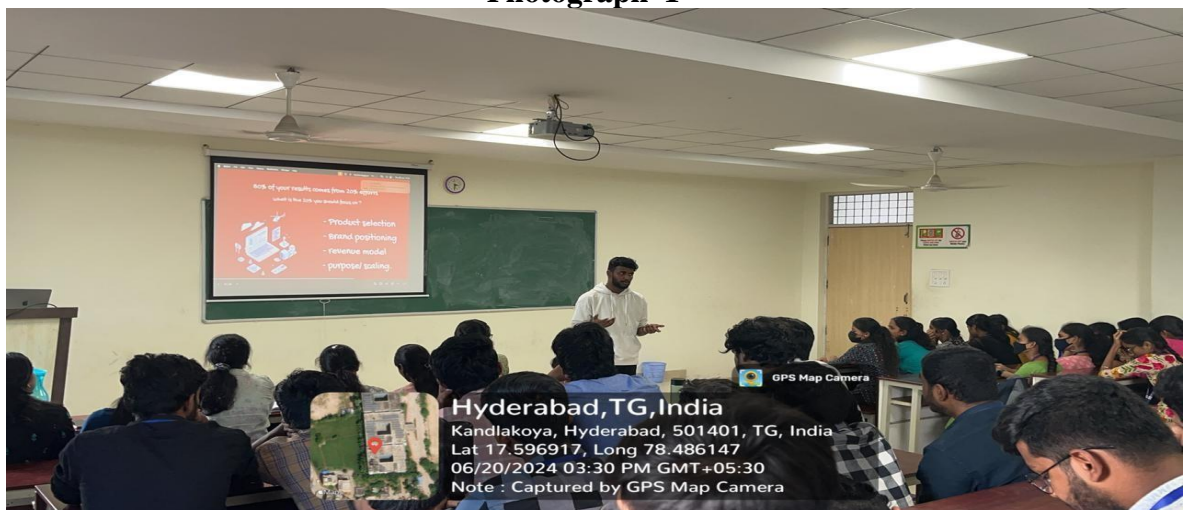

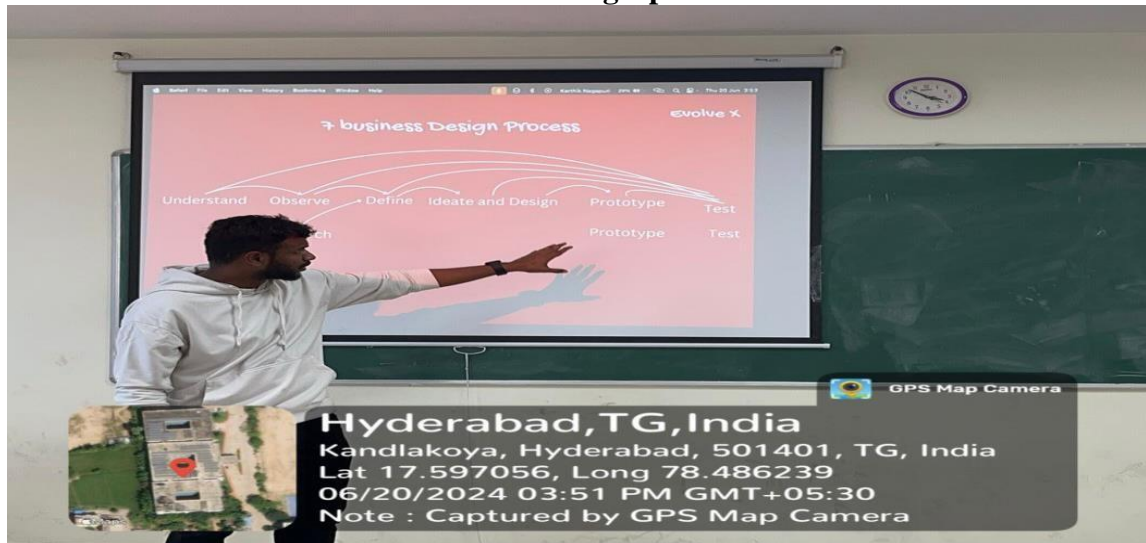
