Description about the Event: On 29th August 2024, the Anti-Ragging Committee of CMRTC held a meeting at the Abdul Kalam Seminar Hall, Kandlakoya, Medchal, organized by the Anti-Ragging Committee. The session, led by Dr. A. Raji Reddy, Director of CMRTC, focused on the duties of the Anti-Ragging Squad across various campus locations. The event saw the participation of 204 faculty members, students, and staff, alongside deans and heads of departments.

Dr. Reddy emphasized the importance of a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging, outlining the squad's responsibilities, which include vigilant monitoring of identified ragging-prone areas, conducting surprise checks, and ensuring immediate support for students. He also discussed the need for effective coordination with local authorities and the availability of support mechanisms such as helplines and counselling services.
