- Achievements in project expos can be a valuable addition to resumes and academic portfolios.

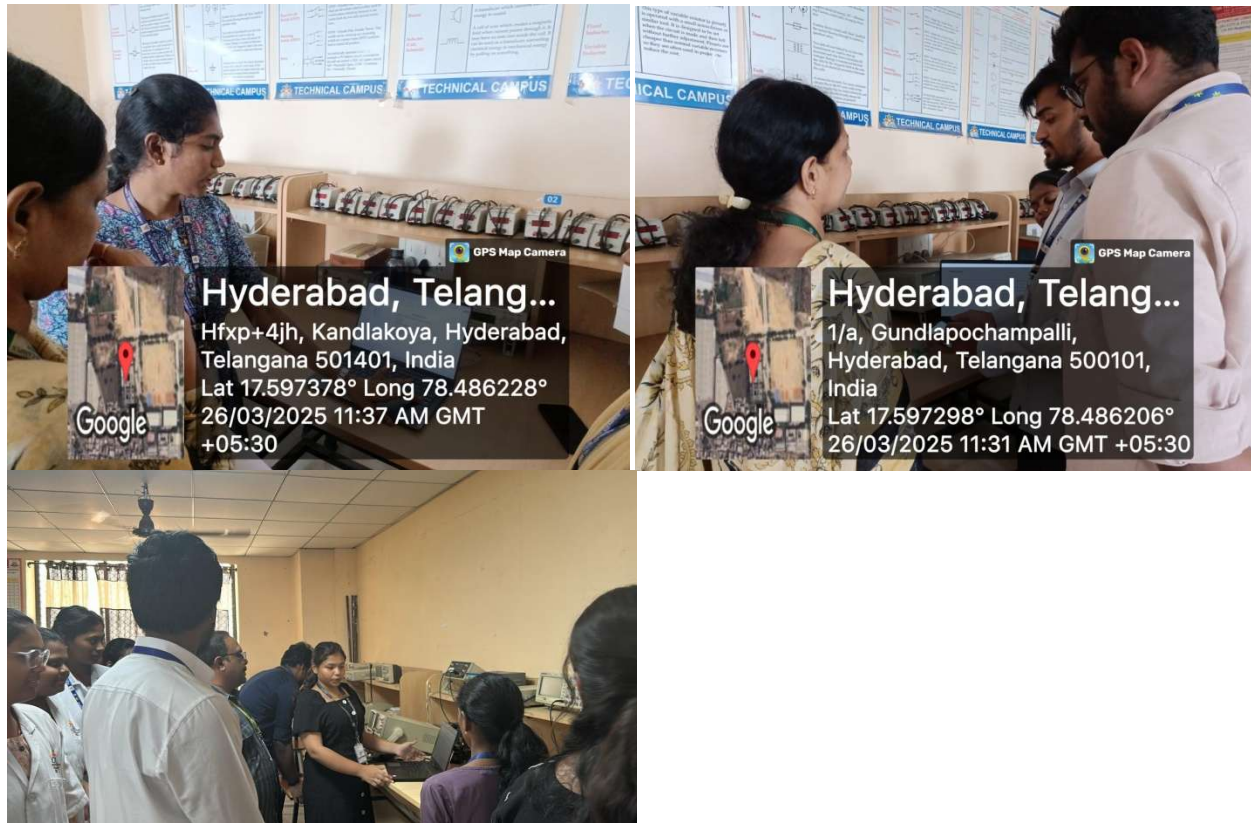
