14. VISIT TO ADOPTED VILLAGE AND SCHOOL, GOWDAVELLI



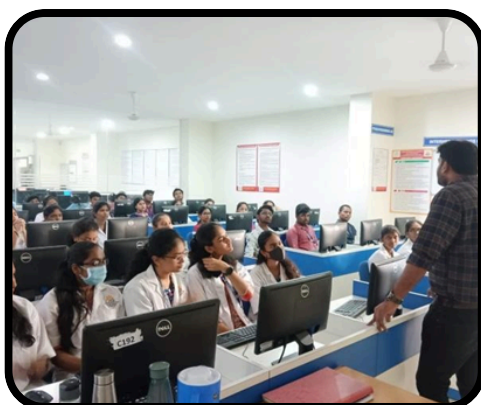

17. OLD CLOTHES DONATION DRIVE

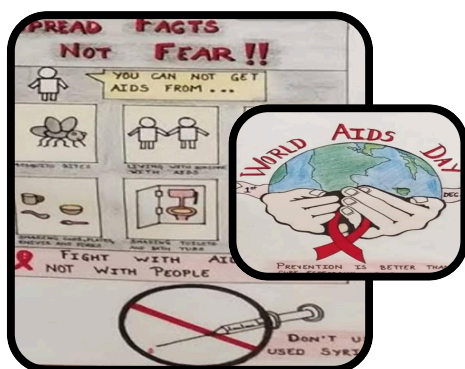

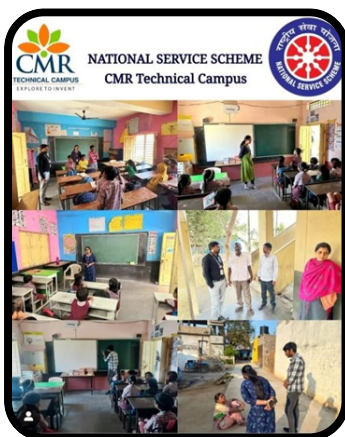


33. A SOCIAL AWARENESS PROGRAM ON CORONA VIRUS BY PATANJALI WELLNESS HOSPITAL

55. GIRL CHILD AWARENESS AND ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS PROGRAM

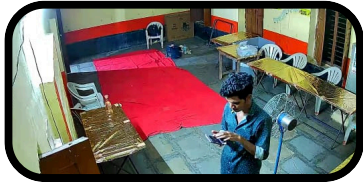
