

Item No. 2025.2.07: Approval of R25 B. Tech., M. Tech. & MBA Academic Regulations & Course Structure.

The Member Secretary presented the R25 B. Tech., M. Tech. & MBA Academic Regulations & Course Structure.

The Board discussed and approved R25 B. Tech Academic Regulations, Four Years Course Structure and I & II Year Syllabus of CSE, CSE(AIML), CSE (Data Science) & ECE recommended by Academic Council.

R25 B. Tech. Academic Regulations: New Implementations

1. B. Tech Program Structure: Each student shall register 164 credits and secure minimum 160 credits for award of the B. Tech degree.
2. Provision for early registration of MOOCs: For a professional elective in a semester, students are allowed to register for an equivalent MOOCs course one semester in advance.
3. Mid Term Examinations for 30 Marks:
 - a. PART - A: Descriptive paper for Part-A (10 marks) Consists of one compulsory question with 5 sub questions carrying 2 marks each. (Note: JNTUH – Objective/Quiz paper for 10 Marks)
 - b. PART – B: Descriptive paper for Part-B (20 marks) consists of 3 questions (May contain sub questions) with internal choice. The student has to answer all the questions. (Note: JNTUH – External Choice, Any 4 questions out of 6 questions)
4. No Minimum marks for passing in internal examinations.
(Note: Minimum 35% of CIE in R22 Regulations)
5. A Computer-Based Test (CBT) in each course is available for students who either:
 - a. Missed one of the two mid-term examinations due to unavoidable circumstances, or
 - b. Attended both mid-term examinations but wish to improve their internal marks.
6. UG Project Work: The duration of the project work is one semester (IV Year II Semester)
(Note: Project Stage – I & Project Stage – II in IV – I & IV – II in R22 Regulations)
7. Value-Added Courses: with credits
(Note: Mandatory courses without credits in R22 Regulations)
8. Multiple Entry Multiple Exit Scheme (MEME): Students are permitted to exit the program after successful completion of the second year only & may apply for re- entry into the Third Year.
(Note: After II Year & III Year in R22)


