Accept your offer by paying your deposit

To confirm your acceptance, you must pay your pre-registration deposit of £3000.00 within 28 days of receiving your offer. If you are being sponsored by a third party, such as your government or employer, a deposit payment is not required, but you must provide proof of sponsorship within the same 28-day period. Requirements for proof of sponsorship can be found [here](#). If you do not accept your offer within 28 days, then we can no longer guarantee your place, and your course may close if it becomes full. If you do not pay within the 28-day period, you should check the [Closed Course Webpage](#) to check if your course is still open for deposit payments.

The pre-registration deposit is the first payment of your tuition fees and reduces the amount payable on registration. It also qualifies you to begin the CAS process for your Student Visa application. The University requires students to make all payments to us using our payment platform, Flywire for Students, which allows you to pay fees in your local currency and significantly reduces payment fees charged by your bank. If you are 'sponsored' by a government and/or organisation, you can provide us with proof of this in order to accept your offer to international@gre.ac.uk.

Visa information

As an international student, you may require a visa to study with us. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are in possession of a valid visa for studying at the University.

Most students will obtain a visa by applying for a Student visa from the UK Government. To apply for this visa, you will require a Confirmation of Acceptance for Study (CAS) number issued by the University of Greenwich. The University will begin the CAS issuance process once you have paid the £3,000 pre-registration deposit or have provided proof of sufficient financial sponsorship. You must also complete other pre-CAS issuance checks within our CAS Shield system. Depending on where you are applying from, you may also need to complete a 'credibility' interview to ensure you are prepared for your

Some postgraduate programmes in the field of Engineering may require an ATAS certificate before we can issue you a CAS. Please check if this applies to you by visiting our [website](#).

Schedule of fees

Please see below schedule of fees required both before and during your studies.

- [Acceptance deposit](#) - within 28 days - £3000.00 (sponsored students can confirm via email)
- [CAS issuance](#) - the same £3000.00 deposit payment (or documentary evidence if sponsored) can be used to release your CAS statement. Students from certain countries will have to pay a minimum of 50% of your first year's tuition fee in order to release your CAS. The CAS team will inform you of this during the CAS issuance process. Any scholarships awarded to you will also be included on your CAS statement.
- [Registration fees](#) - to be able to register and start your course, including accessing online learning materials you will need to pay a minimum of 50% of your total 1st year tuition fees. Any monies paid to receive your CAS can be deducted from this 50%. Sponsored students can use evidence on sponsorship to confirm this.
- [Remaining fees](#) - the final 50% of tuition is then due in installments over the first semester.
