



III and IV years of R20 B. Tech (IT) scheme considered same as B. Tech (CSE), the committee has suggested a few modifications in the syllabus.

- Syllabus reduction in the course Machine Learning.
- Soft Computing course must be moved to IV year PE-4 from III year PE-1.
- The course Cryptography and Network Security may be moved to 3<sup>rd</sup> year 2<sup>nd</sup> semester instead of 4<sup>th</sup> year 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
- MOOCs courses are offered in Professional Electives.

### **Resolutions**

Based upon the recommendations suggested by the committee, the Machine Learning course syllabus has been reduced. The soft computing course has been moved from PE-1 to PE-4. We are continuing the course Cryptography and Network Security as it is. MOOCs courses are offered in professional electives.

The BOS members expressed their high appreciation and satisfaction with the courses and activities of the Department.
