

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding is made and executed at CMR Technical Campus Kandlakoya(v) on the (-----).

The MoU signifies a statement of intent for collaboration between

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. PARTIES AND THEIR INTENT:

- a. **First Party** is a leading provider of comprehensive training and technology solutions engaged in Campus Recruitment Training, Corporate Training, Product Development, Skill Development and Placement Services.
- b. **Second party (College)** is a higher Educational Institution committed in providing a holistic environment to their students for a greater learning and competency.
- c. First party and Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of the with enhanced opportunities.

- d.** The parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within areas of Technical Skill Based Training to the students.

2. NATURE OF RELATIONSHIP

- d.** The second party shall provide all the necessary facilities such as infrastructure, IOT equipment, network and internet access required for education and training purposes as the program is conducted in the college premises.
- e.** The second party shall provide refreshment (lunch) to the trainers during the training period.
- f.** The first party shall provide training for the candidates and the data of such students to be shared by the second party well in advanced for structuring the activity in the best possible way.

5. SCOPE OF MoU

The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

The second party can give valuable inputs to the first party in teaching/training methodologies and assist in customizing the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

6. MUTUAL OBLIGATION

Both parties shall maintain confidentiality about any information, plans, discussions, strategies or any material which shall be deemed to be confidential and marked accordingly

7. LIMITATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- a.** Neither party shall make, revise, alter, or otherwise diverge from the terms, conditions or policies which are subject to this agreement without a written amendment to this agreement.
- b.** Each party represents that they have full power and authority to enter this MOU in general.

8. VALIDITY

This agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **EZ TRAININGS AND TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD**, the first party will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of the training, the party after termination of this agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU. Both parties shall terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writings. In the event of termination, both parties must discharge their obligations.

9. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that first party and second party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither party authorized to use the other party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied on behalf of the other party, without prior written consent of the other party. Neither party shall have, represent itself as having any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party, to pledge the other party's credit or to extend credit on behalf of other party.

10. PAYMENT TERMS

- a. Second Party (College) shall pay Rs. 13000/- (inclusive of taxes) per student to the first party for 33 days of comprehensive training in all the modules backed by extensive hand holding of the student for 6 semesters.
- b. Payment milestones:

- c. In case of any reasons the project gets closed before the complete closure, the second party shall proportionately pay the training cost that incurred until that time.
- d. In case of increase in the number of students, the payment shall increase proportionately as discussed.

11. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

- a. This contract will be terminated based on the consensus of both parties.
- b. If the contract is terminated, payment due for the training must be paid to the First party by the Second party
