Overview of the Camp :

Day 1 – 4 February 2026

The programme commenced with an Inaugural Ceremony attended by dignitaries and youth representatives.

A Career Guidance Session was conducted to guide participants on career opportunities and skill development pathways. This was followed by a session by Eagle Force on Anti-Drug Awareness, emphasizing the importance of a healthy and disciplined lifestyle.

In the afternoon, participants visited Himayat Sagar Lake, where they learned about environmental conservation and water resource management.

Day 2 – 5 February 2026

Field Visit

Participants visited prominent historical landmarks:

These visits enhanced awareness of Hyderabad's heritage, culture, and industrial diversity.



Day 3 – 6 February 2026

A session with a professional psychologist focused on mental health awareness and stress management.

A Banking Awareness Session was also conducted to promote financial literacy and safe digital transactions. The day concluded with Cultural Performances by participants.

Day 4 – 7 February 2026

Participants interacted with the Secretary at Lal Bahadur Stadium. An Assembly was conducted during which certificates were distributed by the Chairman in recognition of active participation.
