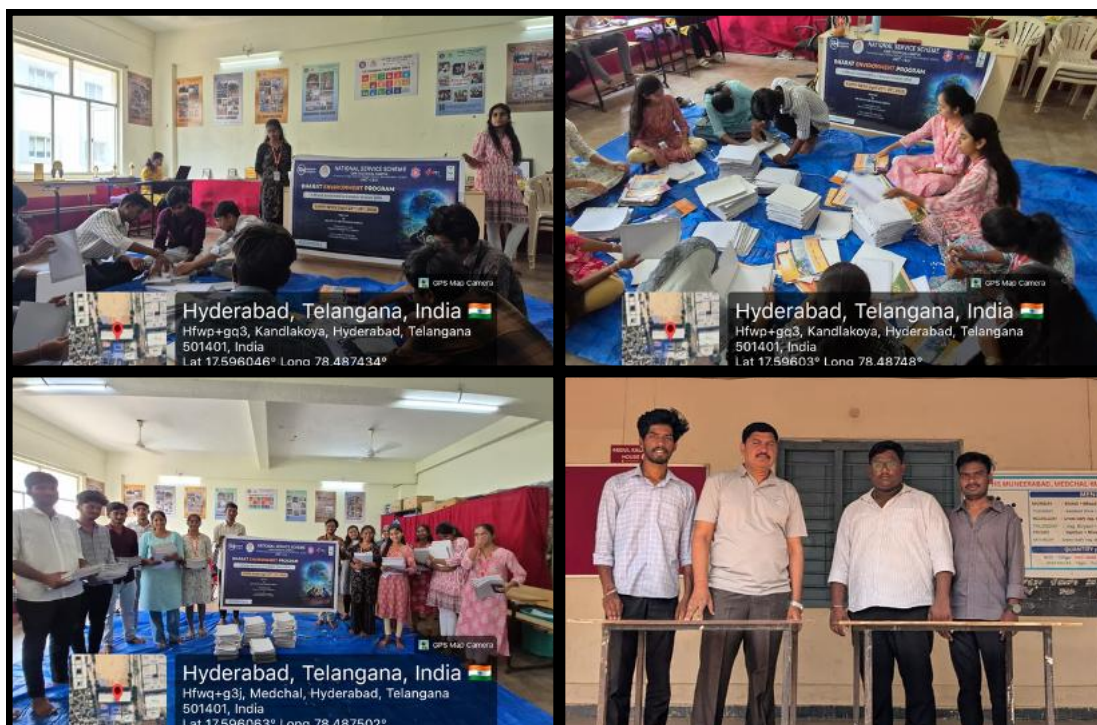

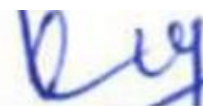

Description of the Event : On 22-04-2026, NSS volunteers participated in a “Best from the Waste” activity as part of the Bharat Environment Program during Earth Week, in collaboration with Research Heights and EPTRI, promoting creativity and environmental awareness. Volunteers used leftover pages from records to make books, which were donated to adopted government schools. They also made paper bags and distributed them to local shops.
